### Sydenham Lawn Tennis and Croquet Club Limited Chairman's report for the year ended 31 March 2009

Dear Member

Due to the national economic downturn, we are aware that we may face the loss of members as people have to face difficult financial choices. However, the directors of the club and the volunteers across the sections continue to explore how to retain members and encourage new ones to join.

Whilst tennis membership remains stable, the squash section goes from strength to strength benefitting from other courts and clubs closing down in the area. Refurbished changing rooms, court repairs and improvements to the fabric of the squash building have ensured we offer a good deal to SLTCC's dedicated band of players and the new members who have joined them.

Croquet facilities at the club have been improved with a new shed paid for by a grant from the Croquet Association and the addition of a smaller shed donated by a member of the section. Sydenham's croquet team continues to maintain its presence in competition matches across the area. The section has offered open days to introduce the sport to others; has dipped its toes into the corporate market by hiring the lawn to an external client and has maintained its membership numbers.

Five tennis teams made it to the end of Summer 09 finals, with two teams – Ladies' 3 and Men's 3 taking the trophies. These successes show how Sydenham is a force to be reckoned with and improve our profile county-wide.

The website has seen a transformation with added features and a professional new look. The members' area gives access to vital information on team matches and league games etc and is a great service for existing members. The site is also an excellent advertisement for the club, to potential members. Dan Stevens, the webmaster, has also introduced the new web and email address - sltcc.co.uk - and we are handling more and more enquiries by email, alongside the traditional method of our answer-phone service.

In April this year, long-time Chair of the Tennis Committee, Jeff Richards, was nominated for and won Volunteer of the Year award in the Kent County Club Awards. This long overdue recognition further raised the Club's profile and we were all incredibly proud of Jeff and this award.

Finally, the 2009 AGM sees the end of an era as Jesper Friis steps down from the Board after ten years service as a director. His time began in 1999, as Tennis Representative on the Board before becoming Chairman of the Club a year later. He was then Chair for an incredible seven years, during which time he oversaw the development of courts 6 & 7, working closely with the then Club Secretary, Richard Cory. After retiring as Chair, Jesper remained on the Board for two years, initially as Premises Director and finally as Company Secretary, ensuring there was a smooth transition with my new tenure as Chair. The club owes him a debt of gratitude and we wish him well in his 'retirement' from the running of the club.

Overall, SLTCC continues to be in great shape – in a healthy financial position with dedicated and hardworking volunteers – in short, a club we should all be immensely proud of.

### 1 Accounting policies

### **Accounting Convention**

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2007).

#### Income

The Club is not registered for VAT and therefore income and expenditure includes VAT.

### Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on tangible fixed assets on a straight line basis so as to write off their cost or valuation over their estimated useful lives as follows

Freehold land Nil
Clubhouse 10 years
All weather tennis courts 9 years
Squash building 15 years

Furniture and equipment of a moveable nature is not capitalised.

No provision has been made in the Accounts for the eventual replacement of freehold buildings

#### Stocks

Stock is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

#### **Taxation**

The Club is registered with HM Revenue and Customs as a Community Amateur Sports Club and (subject to certain exceptions) is exempt from Corporation Tax.

### **Donations to Specific Funds**

(e.g. Junior Development Fund); these are not credited to Income and Expenditure Account when received, but when utilised.

LTA 2	A 10 year loan advanced in April 2004 repayable by twenty biannual from July 2005. No interest is payable. However, it is understood that the interest will be demanded if there is a default of the conditions of the loan.
Members' 1988 scheme	These were advanced in the two years ended 31st March 1988 and were for a minimum term of 5 years, but repayable on request and subject to Board approval.

### **Property Revaluation Reserve**

The freehold land, clubhouse, squash building and tennis courts were revalued by the directors at 1st April 1990 at £300,000 on a current use value. This valuation includes plant and equipment of a fixed nature, (electric wring, plumbing, heating system, security grills, etc).

The original surplus on revaluation of £258,012 has been credited to Property Revaluation Reserve together with a surplus of £2,972 arising from the revaluation of all-weather tennis court 1 and 2 on 1 November 1995. This reserve is reduced annually by a transfer to the credit of Income and Expenditure Account in respect of that part of the revaluation depreciated in the year. (No further transfers are made subsequent to March 2005).

### 8 Deferred Grant Reserve

During 2004/05, £54,000 was donated to the Club to facilitate its development programme to convert 2 grass courts into 2 floodlit porous acrylic courts (courts 6 & 7), to resurface 2 existing courts (courts 3 & 4) and upgrade the practice wall. This amount is being amortised over nine years i.e. the life of the asset constructed.
